

Google Map iFrame Script Setup Guide

The admin can configure Google map iframe from **System Settings > General > Basic sub-tab.**

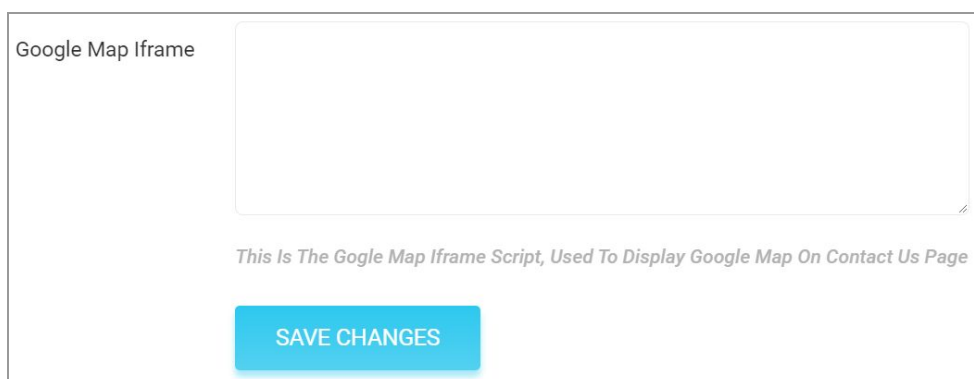


Fig. 1: Google Map iframe Settings at Admin-end

The steps to be followed are:

1. Visit **Google maps** and search the place or address whose location is to be embedded.

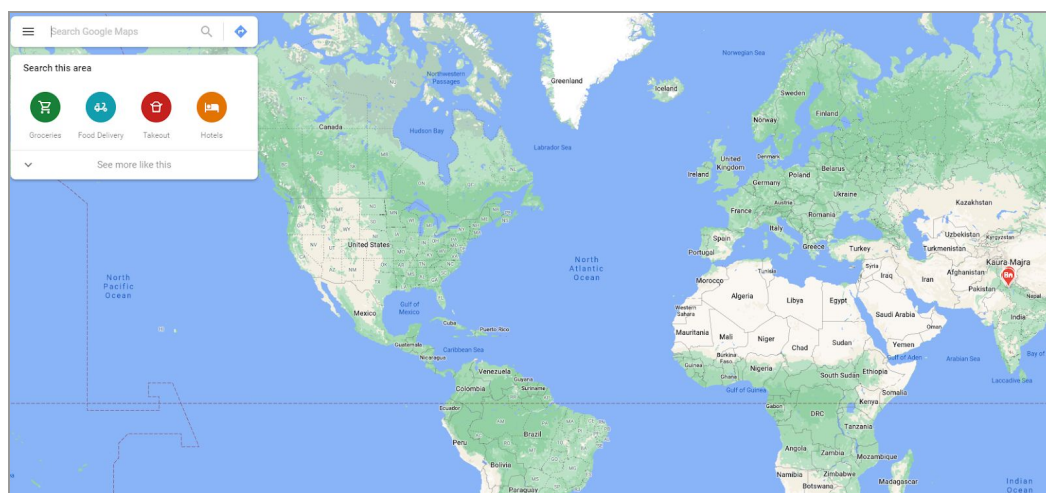


Fig. 2: Search Location on Google Maps

2. Once the location has been searched, click on the **'Share'** button provided on the left side navigation bar.

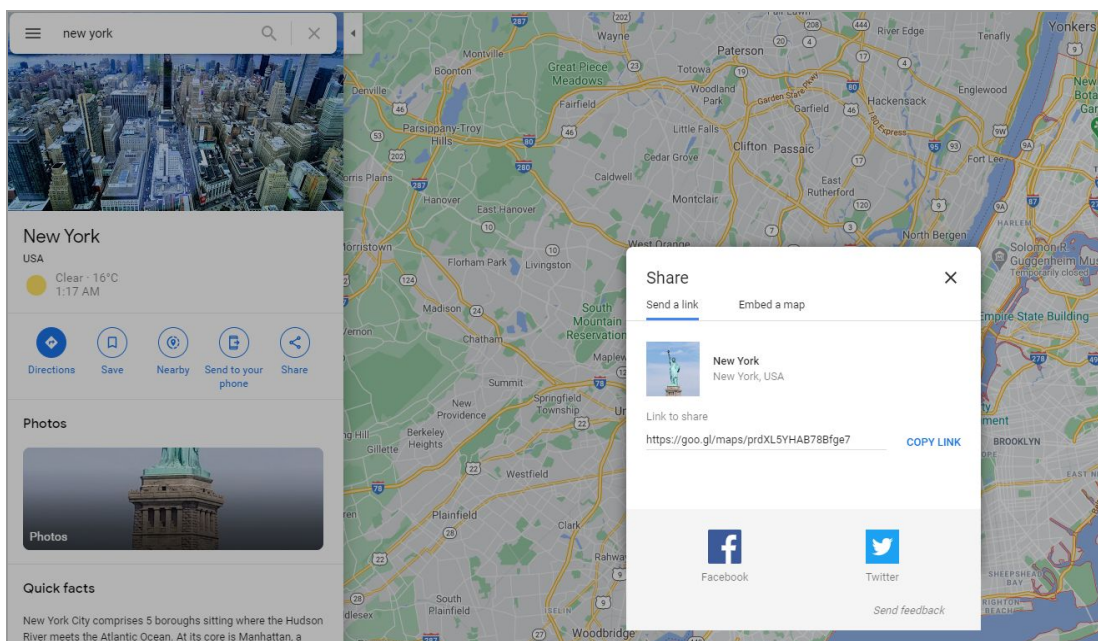


Fig. 3: 'Share' pop-up menu

3. A pop-up box will appear which will display two tabs. Click on the **'Embed a Map'** tab as shown below.

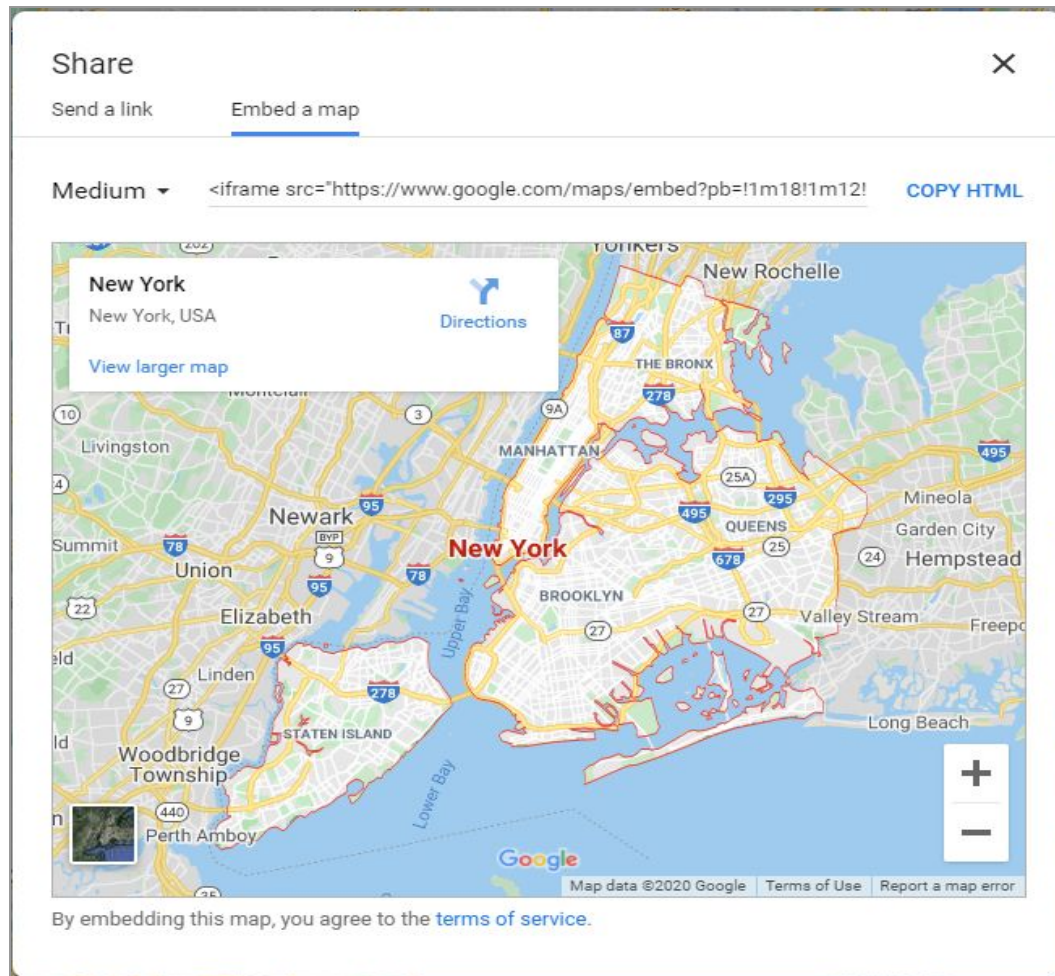


Fig. 4: 'Embed a Map' tab

4. Click on the '**Copy HTML**' button provided besides the iframe. The iframe will be copied. Paste this iframe in the dashboard settings as shown in [figure 1](#).
