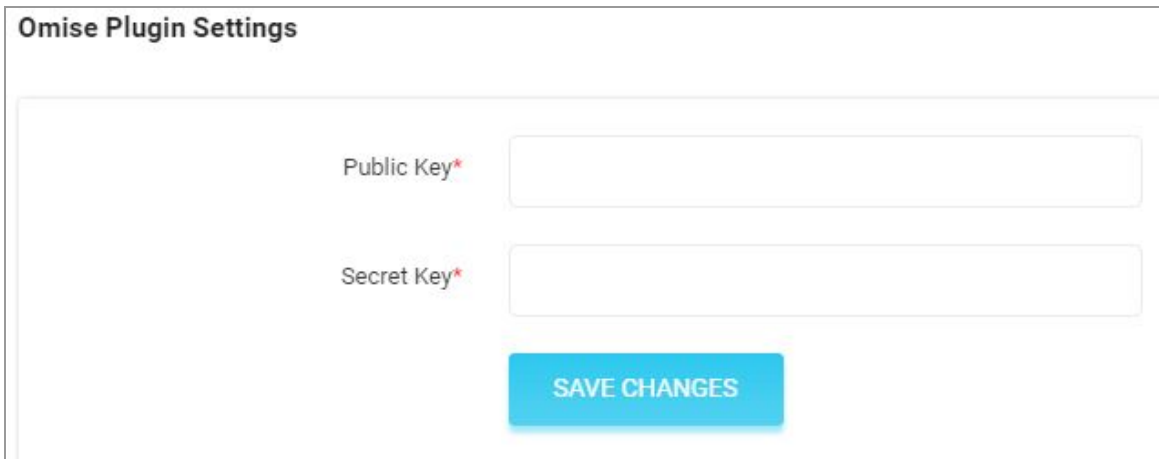


Omise Plugin API Keys Setup Guide

To configure **Omise Plugin**, the admin needs to enter the necessary keys provided in **System Settings > Plugins > Regular Payment Methods > Omise > Settings Icon**.



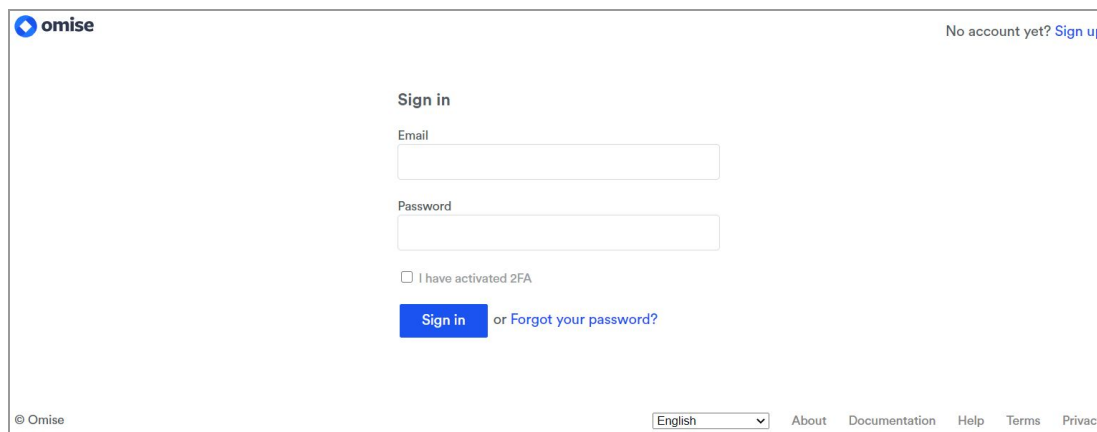

To configure Omise plugin, please follow the below steps -

1. Visit <https://dashboard.omise.co/signin> and **Sign In** with your valid credentials or register by clicking on the '**Sign Up**' button provided on the top-right corner of this page.

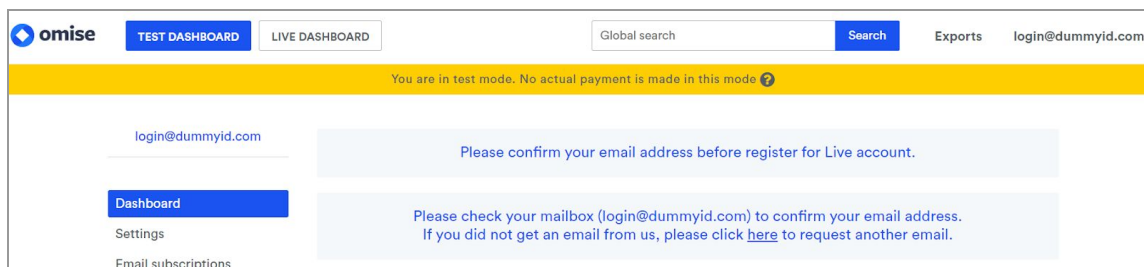

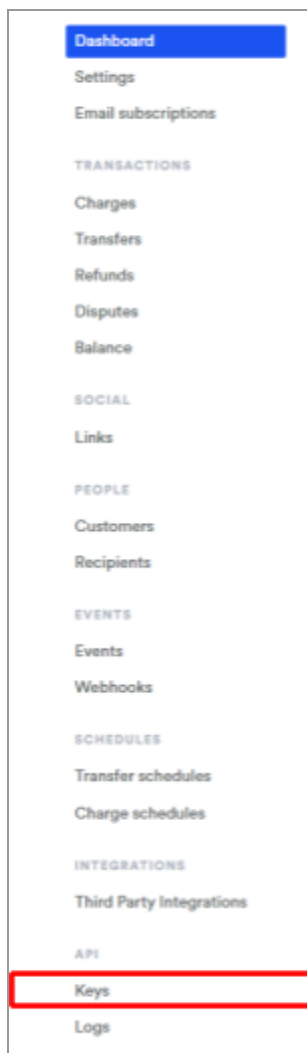


Fig. 4: Side Navigation bar

- From the side-navigation bar, click on the '**Keys**' option displayed under **API** section as shown in the figure 4 below.

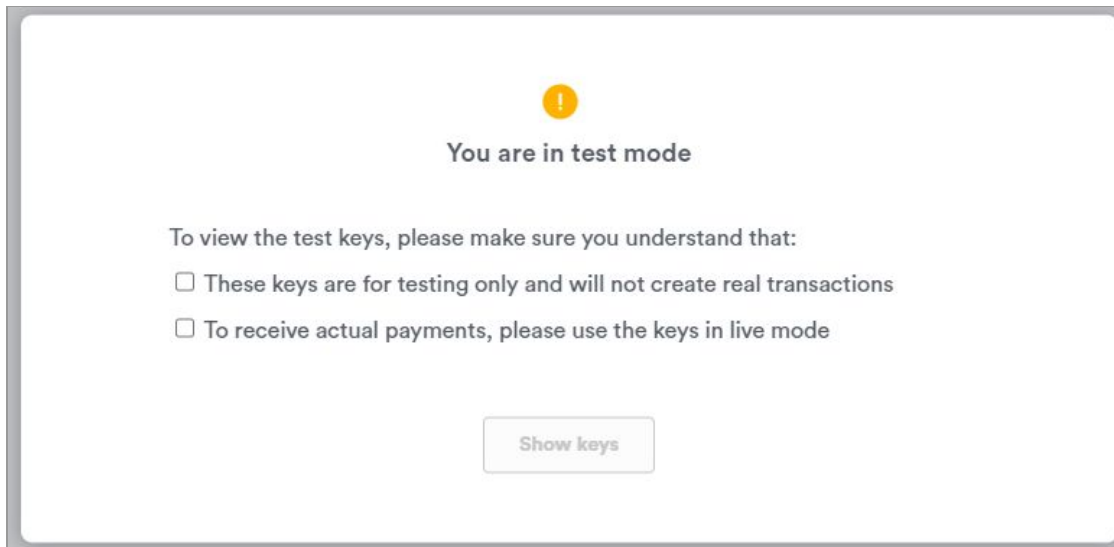


Fig. 5: Pop-up Message

5. The **'Public Key'** and **'Secret Key'** will be displayed on the page as shown in the figure 6 below. The admin needs to copy and paste these keys in the respective input fields provided on their panel ([Figure 1](#)).

API Keys

! These keys are for testing only and **will not** create real transactions. To create real transactions (that is, receive actual payments) please use the keys in live dashboard.

Public key

The public key can be used to create tokens via javascript from your customers browsers. This key can be safely exposed to the outside world.

Secret key

The secret key can be used to create customers, cards and charges and to retrieve information about your account, such as its balance. You must keep this key from prying eyes.

Rolling your key will create a new one for you to use and expire the current one 60 minutes later. You can revoke expiring keys to make them unusable immediately.
